Neurovascular Registered Nurse (NVRN-BCTM)

The NVRN-BC[™] board certification examination is the only certification for registered nurses that focuses exclusively on acute neurovascular care.

Attainment of NVRN-BC[™] certification demonstrates nursing expertise in the provision of acute neurovascular care to highly vulnerable, hospitalized acute stroke patients.

- ✓ Eligibility requirements include:
 - Licensed as a registered nurse in country of origin
 - Evidence of provision of a minimum of 1,000 hours of clinical care to acute stroke patients in the immediate 12 months preceding application. Clinical care hours may include provision of any of the following: consultation, direct clinical care, participation in research or quality improvement projects, administration, stroke center coordination, or provision of nursing staff or patient education.

Advanced Neurovascular Practitioner (ANVP-BCTM)

The ANVP-BC™ board certification examination is the premier certification in acute neurovascular clinical practice for non-physician, advanced practice clinicians. Exam eligibility is supported with strict eligibility criteria, ensuring certification of clinicians capable of combining theoretical knowledge with expert clinical practice skills.

- ✓ Eligibility requirements include:
 - Evidence of completion of a post-graduate (post-Master's degree) acute neurovascular fellowship program with completion of a minimum of 1,000 clinical hours of advanced training and education in the area of acute neurovascular disease.


