

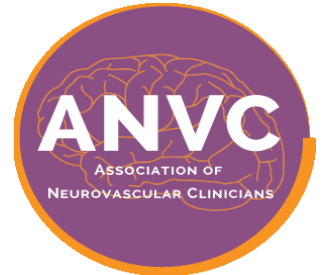
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# **Acute Neurovascular RN (NVRN - BC) Review Course**

## **Course Description:**

Designed to help Registered Nurses prepare for the Neurovascular Registered Nursing board certification examination, the Acute Neurovascular RN Review Course is a 2-day intensive review. The Neurovascular Registered Nurse board certification (NVRN-BC) exam is the only certification for registered nurses that focuses exclusively on acute neurovascular care. Attainment of NVRN-BC certification demonstrates nursing expertise in the provision of acute neurovascular care to highly vulnerable, hospitalized acute stroke patients.



**Who Should Attend:** Registered Nurses interested in Acute Neurovascular RN board certification, RNs working in the ED, interventional radiology, critical care and stroke units who care for acute stroke patients, stroke program coordinators and RNs interested in learning more about stroke care.
