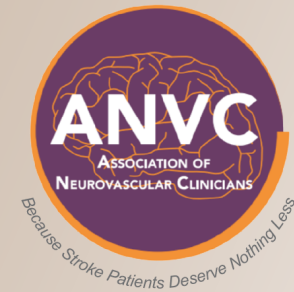

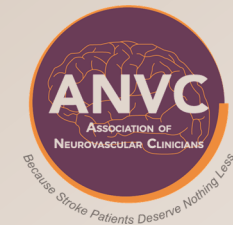

## Eligibility Requirements

- Licensed as a registered nurse in country of origin
- Evidence of provision of a minimum of 1,000 hours of clinical care to acute stroke patients in the immediate 12 months preceding application; Clinical care hours may include provision of any of the following: consultation, direct clinical care, participation in research or quality improvement projects, administration, stroke center coordination or provision of nursing staff or patient education

*If you do not have 1000 hours, but believe you have accumulated enough expertise to be successful on the examination, you may obtain your supervisor's signature indicating that he/she agrees that you have the requisite knowledge to sit for the certification examination.*
